Greg Vogelweid, Chief Executive Officer

Greg is a native St. Louisan and a graduate of St. Louis University. He is a veteran of thirty years experience in financial and operational functions of large St. Louis companies. He has been with St. Patrick Center for more than seventeen years.

In the fall of 1993, Greg came to the St. Patrick Center as a volunteer, working for Leo Paradis to set up its first automated budget and to help construct the agency's first Strategic Plan. He has since worked on the two additional strategic plans for the St. Patrick Center. Greg was also the lead in completing the first accreditation process with the Council on Accreditation. From his first job as Director of Finance, he was promoted to Chief Operating Officer in 2001 after having served as Interim Executive Director for a year during St. Patrick Center's Capital Campaign in 2000. After the departure of St. Patrick Center CEO Dan Buck in October 2010, St. Patrick Center's Board of Directors appointed Greg as the Interim Chief Executive Officer. He currently serves in the role during the official search for a permanent replacement.

The Governor of Missouri appointed Greg to the Governor's Committee on Ending Chronic Homelessness in 2003 and was then appointed to the Restructuring Committee for the City Homeless Network Board in 2005. Greg has consulted with numerous social service agencies on Best Practices for the administration and financial management of a social service agency. Greg and his wife Maggie moved into an historic co-op in the City of St. Louis in 2000 and have three children and four grandchildren.
