OUR mission

St. Patrick Center provides opportunities for self-sufficiency and dignity to persons who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Individuals achieve permanent, positive changes in their lives through affordable housing, sound mental health, employment and financial stability.



ROSATI APARTMENTS **A St. Patrick Center Housing Program**

In October 2008, St. Patrick Center and Catholic Charities opened Rosati Apartments, a 26-unit apartment complex that provides permanent supportive housing for homeless persons with co-occurring disorders of mental illness and substance abuse. Each unit is comprised of a sitting/sleeping area, an eat-in kitchen with Energy Star appliances and a private bath. Rosati residents also enjoy 24-hour front desk attendance and opportunities to take part in a variety of group activities.

14 units of Rosati Apartments are reserved for persons who are former residents of the St. Louis Rehabilitation Center, and these residents receive visits from that organization's case managers.

However, residents of the other 12 units in Rosati Apartments, along with 30 individuals housed in private apartments of the St. Louis community, receive in-home assistance from Rosati's multi-disciplinary team that includes a Team Manager, a Nurse, a Substance-Abuse Counselor, a Mental-Health Counselor and a Financial-Stability Counselor. These residents receive one or more weekly visits from the team, based on individual resident's needs and active symptoms. Although each team member works with residents in a specific area of expertise, they also act collectively to assist residents in becoming sober, stable and as self-sufficient as possible. Also, any available team member responds to consumer crises. St. Patrick Center provides these 42 individuals with over two-thirds of their rent and some utility assistance.

In Fiscal Year 2009, we placed 26 chronically homeless men and women into Rosati Apartments. Of the 26, 14 also received supportive case management services. In addition, 30 formerly homeless individuals were placed in scattered sites within St. Louis City limits.
