St. Patrick Center provides opportunities for self-sufficiency and dignity to persons who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Individuals achieve permanent, positive changes in their lives through affordable housing, sound mental health, employment and financial stability.



ROSATI APARTMENTS & ASSERTIVE COMMUNITY TREATMENT **A St. Patrick Center Housing Program**

In October 2008, St. Patrick Center and Catholic Charities opened Rosati Apartments, an apartment complex that provides permanent supportive housing for homeless persons with co-occurring disorders of mental illness and substance abuse. Each unit is comprised of a sitting/sleeping area, an eat-in kitchen with Energy Star appliances and a private bath. Rosati residents also enjoy 24-hour front desk attendance and opportunities to take part in a variety of group activities.

The residents of the 12 units in Rosati Apartments, along with 30 individuals housed in private apartments of the St. Louis community, receive in-home assistance from Rosati's multi-disciplinary Assertive Community Treatment team that includes a Team Manager, a Nurse, a Substance-Abuse Counselor, a Mental-Health Counselor and a Financial-Stability Counselor. These residents receive one or more weekly visits from the team, based on individual resident's needs and active symptoms. Although each team member works with residents in a specific area of expertise, they also act collectively to assist residents in becoming sober, stable and as self-sufficient as possible. Also, any available team member responds to consumer crises. St. Patrick Center provides these 42 individuals with over two-thirds of their rent and some utility assistance.

In Fiscal Year 2011, Rosati Apartments provided case management services and housing for a year or more to 18 chronically homeless men and women in our permanent, supportive housing complex. In addition, 3 residents graduated into independent apartments in the community and 2 were moved to more supervised settings to meet their treatment needs.

In Fiscal Year 2011, Rosati Assertive Community Treatment provided permanent housing, mental health and substance abuse counseling, employment and financial guidance services to 19 Rosati Apartment ACT residents and up to 32 chronically homeless individuals living at other sites in the community.
