## Join St. Patrick Center's Casserole Program!

In 1984, just a year after St. Patrick Center was founded, the agency established a **highly structured network of parish and civic groups to provide casseroles to feed the homeless and poor**. Casserole program founder Susan Reese worked closely with St. Patrick Center founder Edith Cunnane to build a no-cost system of providing hot, nutritious meals to those in need.

Today, the Casserole Program continues with amazing success! In Fiscal Year 2009, 2,300 casserole volunteers from **more than 70 church and community groups provided more than 157,000 hot meals** for St. Patrick Center's Shamrock Club, Rosati Group Home and Shamrock Evening Program (Alumni Club).
